

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Yukon Residential Schools Missing Children Project

As you know, the Department of Education has shared information from the Yukon Residential School Missing Children Project about work they've started in the Riverdale neighbourhood. The Yukon Residential Schools Missing Children Project conducts survivor interviews, archival research and ground searches to uncover the truth about children who attended Yukon residential schools.

Values and Ethics Code

As you might recall, our <u>Values and Ethics Code</u> was launched last year to clearly articulate what it means to be a public servant and how we conduct ourselves professionally. There is a new verification tool to help ensure all public servants are familiar with the Code. Accessing the verification tool is straightforward:

• The tool is on My HR File, where you usually enter your leave requests and timesheets.

 Once you have read the Values and Ethics Code or completed the online training, click on "Values and Ethics Code" on the Employee Self Service page on My HR File and check the box that says "Read and Agreed" and click submit.

I ask you all to take the time to familiarize yourself with the code, complete the verification at your earliest convenience, and to consider how you are bringing the values and ethics forward in the important work you do.
