The Gord Downie & Chanie Wenjack Fund (DWF) has compiled a <u>resource list</u> that educators can use to teach their students what this important day means.

DWF encourages all educators to use these resources, including <u>Reclaiming Power and Place: The National</u> <u>Inquiry's Final Report</u>. This report reveals that persistent and deliberate human and Indigenous rights violations and abuses are the root cause behind Canada's high rates of violence against Indigenous women, girls, and LGBTQ2S+ people.

Yukon Breeze Sailing Society pilot program

The Yukon Breeze Sailing Society (YBSS) is thrilled to introduce Yukon's first School Sailing Program. This program is designed to introduce students in Grades 5 to 12 to the exciting sport of sailing at YBSS' site on Schwatka Lake. Students will learn the basics of sailing, including rigging a boat, steering, tacking, getting in and out of irons, heading up, bearing off, and following a windward and leeward course.

This program aligns with many of the core competencies and outcomes of the Grade 5-12 curriculum, making it an excellent opportunity for students to broaden their horizons while also meeting educational goals. The School Sailing Program is offered over 2 full-days or 4 half-days, with a total of 10 hours of instruction. We encourage all interested students to join us and discover the joys of sailing!
