## PUBLIC EDUCATIONAL MATERIALS ON YUKON LAND CLAIMS AND SELF-GOVERNMENT

**Mapping the Way** is public education campaign aimed at raising awareness and understanding of the Yukon Final and Self-Government Agreements. The initiative is a partnership between the 11 Self-Governing Yukon First Nations, the Council of Yukon First Nations, and the governments of Yukon and Canada.

Mapping the Way has a number of resources available for order or loan that can be used at events or in classrooms.
