

#### Yukon Breeze Sailing Society Pilot Program

The Yukon Breeze Sailing Society (YBSS) is excited to announce the Yukon's first School Sailing Program. The School Sailing Program will introduce students in grades 5 to 12 to the sport of sailing at YBSS' site on Schwatka Lake. Students will learn to rig a boat as well as the basics of sailing including steering, tacking, getting in and out of irons, heading up, bearing off, and following a windward leeward course. This program aligns with many of the core competencies and outcomes of the grade 5-12 curriculum. Each session is offered over 2 full-days or 4 half-days, for a total of 10 hours of instruction. ## **Update on BC Digital Classroom Refresh 2023-2026**

Focused Education has completed the refresh of the BC Digital Classroom **core collection** for 2023-2026.

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They have announced the addition of National Film Board (NFB) Campus, bringing greater Canadian and French language content to teachers and students from K-12. Focused ED anticipate savings for many districts and schools who have licensed NFB as an à la carte option prior to this change.

Twigscience/math resource has been integrated into the core collection for use in Grades 6-9.
