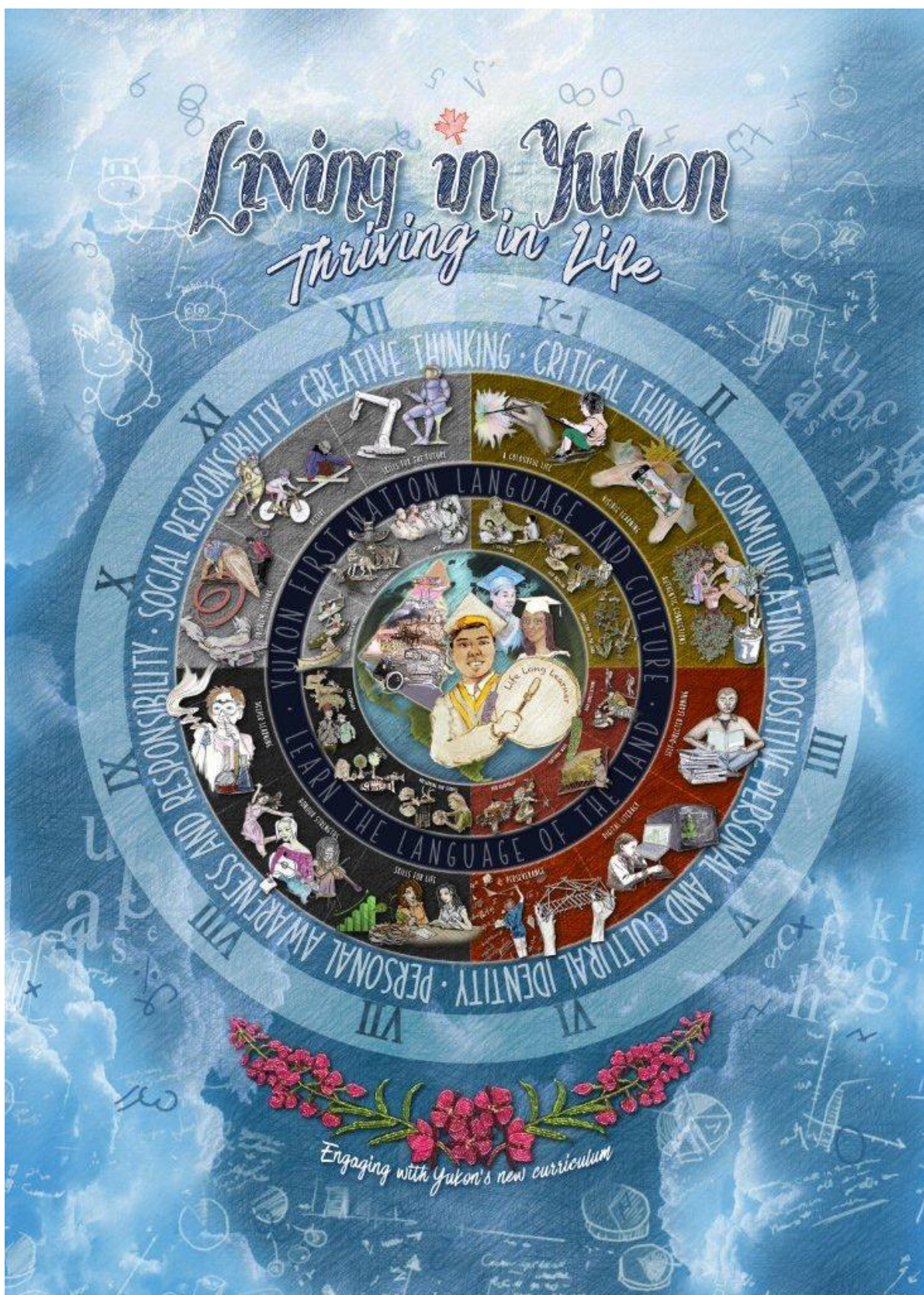

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Reporting and Assessment Guidelines: K-12

Final standards-based summative reports
