## Part 1: Introduction to Web Programming\*

Duration: 9 classes (2 classes per week)

In the first part of the Recoding Futures virtual training program, you'll learn basic web programming skills.

\*Students also have the opportunity to register for Introduction to Social Media Marketing as an additional course during registration.

## Part 2: Programming Language

**Duration:** 3 months

After completing part 1, you'll have an opportunity to continue on to part 2 to learn a more specific programming language. You'll have the qualifications for an entry-level technology position after graduating from the program.

## To be eligible, you must:

- » self-identify as Indigenous;
- » be 15 years old or older;
- » possess basic digital literacy skills;
- » have the ability to study part-time (8 hours a week); and
- » have access to a computer and the internet.
